CALL FOR ENTRIES FOR BALTIC ROWING CHAMPIONSHIPS

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

This year, the Baltic Rowing Championships will be held in Trakai on July 1, with teams from Lithuania, Latvia, and Estonia invited to participate. **In each boat class, two crews from each country are invited to compete.**

II. VENUE LOCATION

The Regatta will take place at the Rowing venue of Lithuanian Sports Centre, Karaimu street 73, Trakai.

III. PRELIMINARY PROGRAMME

A preliminary regatta programme is attached to the invitation. It may be updated depending on the number of entries. Only Final A will be organised. Any updates of the programme will be shared with the team managers via email and the team managers' WhatsApp group.

IV. AGE GROUPS AND BOAT CLASSES

Competitions are held in junior (U19) and senior age groups, 500 and 2000 meters distances. Age groups, boat classes and distances are listed in the table below. Participants must have a valid health certificate and follow into account doctors' medical advice on exercise and have a sports licence.

V. ENTRIES

In each boat class, two crews from each country are invited to compete. The composition of crews in the 500 m and 2000 m races may vary; teams are permitted to enter different crew combinations for each distance.

Entries must be submitted via electronic application system www.e-row.lt. If you have any questions about submitting the entry, please contact entry@lif.lt. **In the online application system, there are two forms of registration. One for 500 meters and a separate for 2000 meters events.**

The regular entry fee applies until June 24 (inclusive). Late entry fees apply from June 25 to June 26. New entries submitted after June 26 will not be accepted. After the application deadline, all crew cancellations and changes must be submitted until June 30 13:00 hrs by sending a completed *Crew Change* form to entry@lif.lt.

- Entry fee shall not be refunded upon crew withdrawal except cases when doctor's certificate stating that the athlete has fallen ill after the entry was submitted. The entry fee already paid will not be credited towards the payment of new crews after the entry deadline.

- If team manager does not withdraw the crew by 13:00 on 30th June, the team will be fined 20 EUR (per crew). If the team manager does not withdraw the crew on time, and the crew does not arrive at the start, the team shall be fined 50 euros (per crew).

VI. AWARDS

The first three places in both age groups will be awarded with medals (separately in 500 and 2000 m events). The awards ceremony will take place immediately after every final A. Team standings will be awarded with a Cup. National team ranking will be determined by points. Points will be awarded to crews based on the results of the finals. The points will be awarded as follows:

1st place - 5 points

2nd place - 3 points

3rd place - 1 point

Team awards ceremony will take place on the award ceremony pontoon immediately after last race.
