CALL FOR ENTRIES FOR THE INTERNATIONAL 64th "AMBER OARS" REGATTA

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

The 64th international Rowing regatta “Amber Oars“ will be held in Trakai on 26-28 June 2026. This regatta is one of Lithuania's largest annual Rowing events, attracting great interest from Lithuanian and foreign athletes and spectators.

II. VENUE LOCATION

The Regatta will take place at the Rowing venue of Lithuanian Sports Centre, Karaimu street 73, Trakai.

III. PRELIMINARY PROGRAMME

A preliminary regatta programme is attached to the invitation. It may be updated depending on the number of entries. Heats will be organised only for events with more than 7 crews. No race for lanes will be organised. Any updates of the programme will be shared with the team managers via email and the team managers' WhatsApp group.

IV. AGE GROUPS AND BOAT CLASSES

Competitions are held in U19, senior and masters age groups. Age groups and boat classes are listed in the table below.

- All athletes of foreign teams must be able to swim and must have undergone a medical check-up, taking full responsibility for their participation in the event. The team manager is required to sign a declaration during the team managers meeting confirming that all athletes are able to swim, have completed a medical check-up, and assume full responsibility for their participation in the event.
- **Athletes holding Russian or Belarusian passports are not allowed to compete.**

Events with only one entry will be canceled. Participants will be given the opportunity to submit a new entry for another event.

V. ENTRIES

Entries are submitted via electronic application system www.e-row.lt. If you have any questions about submitting the entry, please contact entry@lif.lt. **In the online application system, there are two forms of registration. One for Friday – Saturday races and a separate registration for Sunday event.**

The regular entry fee is applied until the 5 pm on 22nd of June. Late entry fees apply from 5 PM on June 22nd until 5 PM on June 23rd. New entries after 5 PM on June 23rd will not be accepted. After the application deadline, via the online application system, crew cancellations and changes must be done by the 25th of June before 1 PM by submitting a completed "Crew change" form to entry@lif.lt.

- Entry fee shall not be refunded upon crew withdrawal except cases when doctor's certificate stating that the athlete has fallen ill after the entry was submitted. The entry fee already paid will not be credited towards the payment of new crews after the entry deadline.
- If the team manager does not withdraw the crew by 1 PM on 25th June, the team will be fined 20 EUR (per crew). If the team manager does not withdraw the crew on time, and the crew does not arrive at the start, the team shall be fined 50 euros (per crew). Fines are payable by bank transfer only. Upon request, an invoice can be issued.
- Please note that the entry fee is applied separately for each set of medals for the Friday-Saturday and Sunday events.
- The entry fee must be paid to the Lithuanian Rowing Federation via the electronic entry system. If the entry fee cannot be paid via entry system, a bank transfer can be made done using the following IBAN (international bank account details):

VI. AWARDS

Winners of the finals on Friday and Saturday will be awarded with sponsors prizes, medals and trophies. Winners of Sunday's final races will be awarded with prizes established by Trakai district municipality.

In events, with only two crews, only the first one is awarded. In the events with three crews, the first and second places will be awarded. This provision does not apply to masters and Pararowing events.
