**58th International “Dangė Regatta”****REGULATIONS****1. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

To promote rowing in Klaipėda and throughout Lithuania, strengthen rowing traditions, identify crews capable of competing successfully at international events, and develop international links.

**2. REGATTA ORGANISERS**

The regatta is organised by the Sports, Youth and Community Affairs Division of the Culture, Sports and Tourism Department of Klaipėda City Municipality Administration, the public institution Klaipėda Rowing Centre, and Klaipėda Rowing Club.

**3. VENUE AND DATES**

The regatta will take place on 9–11 October 2026 on the River Dangė in Klaipėda.

**4. PROGRAMME**

**Friday 9 October – team arrivals.**

**Saturday 10 October**

10:30 – opening ceremony beside the sailing ship Meridianas.

11:00 – racing begins. Crews start at one-minute intervals.

## 5. ENTRIES

Entries must be submitted via the online entry system at **www.e-row.lt**. Before submitting an entry, please ensure that all athlete details are complete and correct. For entry enquiries, email [entry@lif.lt](mailto:entry@lif.lt).

Entries for the first day's events must be submitted by **17:00 on Wednesday 7 October**. No new entries for these events will be accepted after this deadline.

After the entry deadline, crew withdrawals and changes may be submitted **until 13:00 on Friday 9 October** by emailing a completed "Crew change" form to [entry@lif.lt](mailto:entry@lif.lt).

**Mix8+ and Mix4+ crews are to be formed independently by coaches or representatives of cities or countries. All crew members must have raced on the first day of the regatta. Each crew must include at least two women and at least two men. Completed crew line-ups must be registered at [www.e-row.lt](http://www.e-row.lt) by 16:00 on 10 October.**

There is no entry fee.

## 6. AWARDS

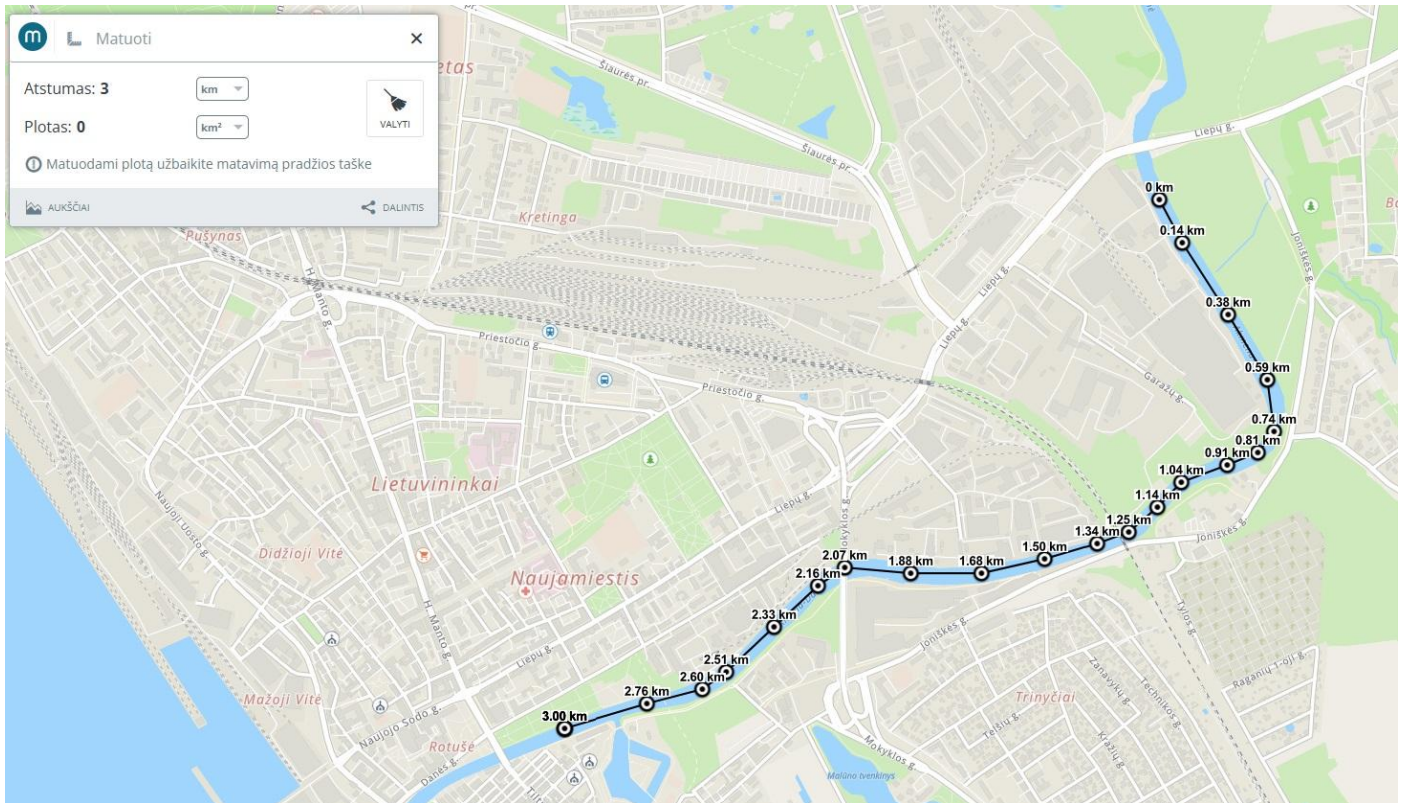
Winners and other medal-winning competitors will receive medals. The prize-giving venue will be announced by 9 October.

The second day's prize-giving will take place at the finish after racing has concluded. The winning Mix8+ crew will receive medals and a cash prize; crews finishing second and third will receive medals.

All participants' expenses are to be covered by their sending organisation.
