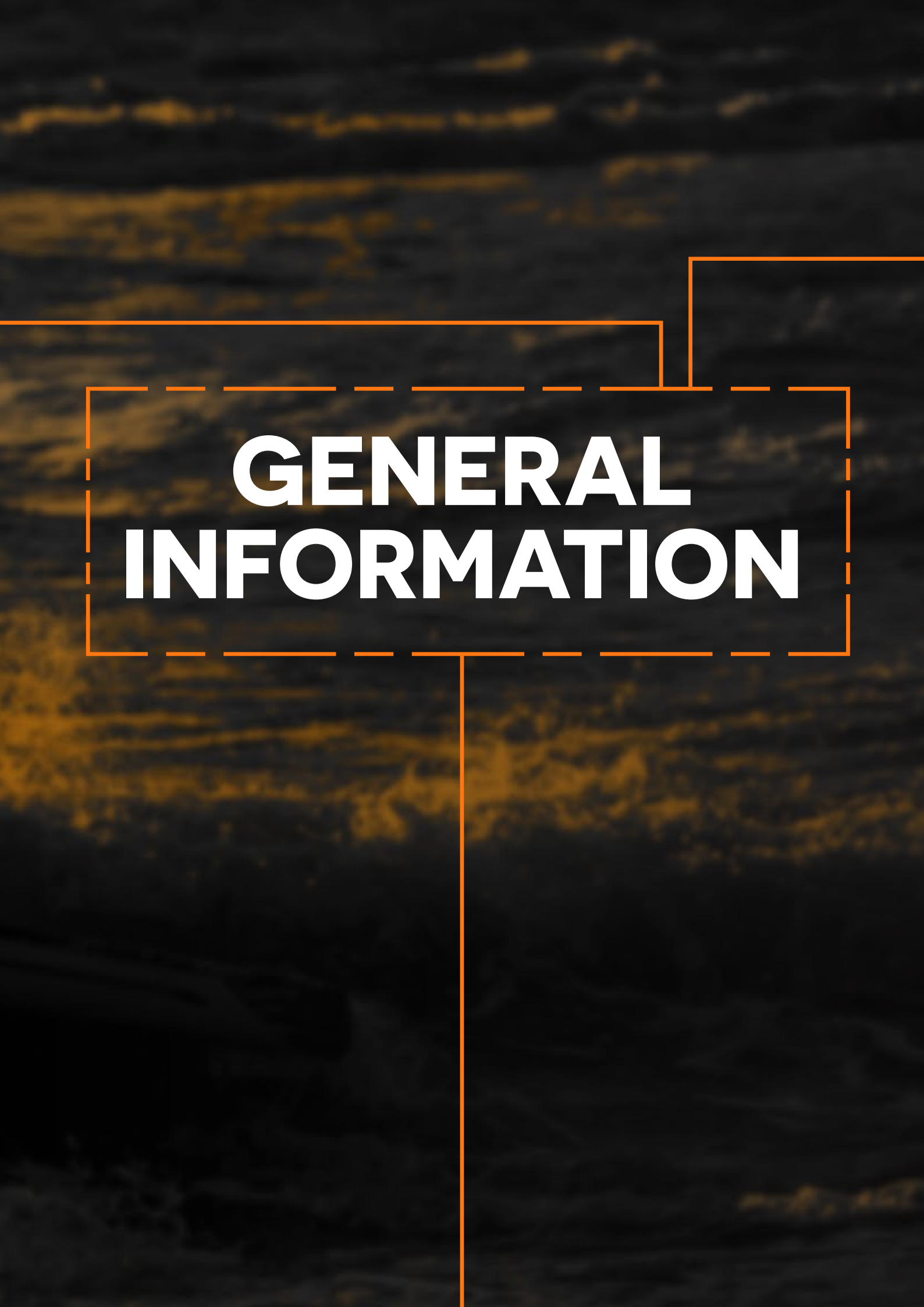

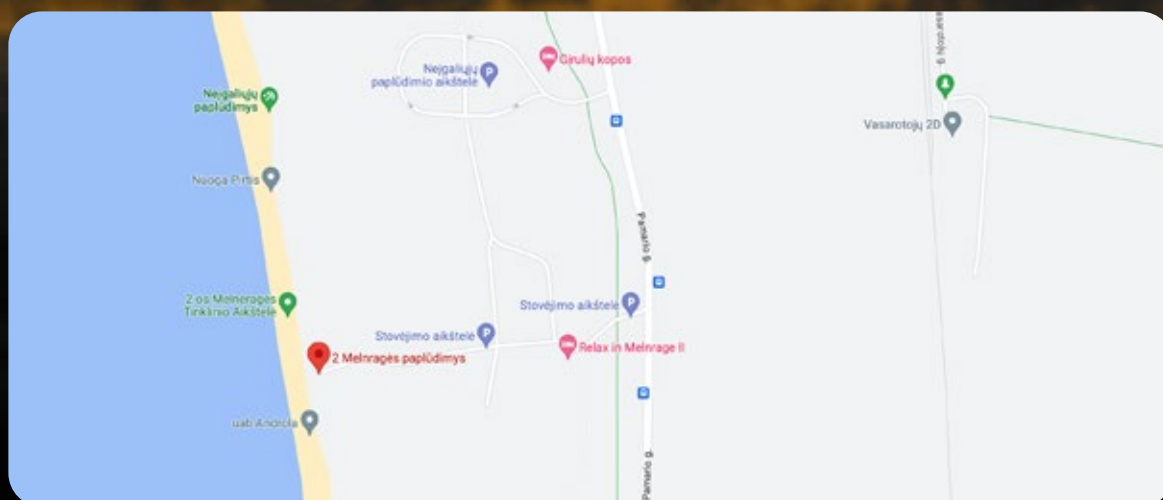

The Coastal Rowing Rules require athletes to make decisions appropriate to their level of skill and experience. Therefore, teams are responsible for ensuring that all their participants have sufficient experience racing in challenging conditions and possess the necessary rowing proficiency.

The organisers will provide coastal rowing boats and oars. Teams are encouraged to provide their own boat holders. If this is not possible, please contact the organisers in advance. Boat holders will be assigned where possible, subject to availability.

COMPETITION RACE FORMAT

First race starts with individual crew qualification, when each athlete/crew starts individually and aims to achieve the fastest time to pass on to next stage. Starts will be given every 5 minutes. Rest of the stages will be in Knock – out racing. There will be a 7 minute time gap between the races, where crews will be allowed to adjust their boats and get ready. When down to the last 8 crews, quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals will run immediately after each other.

ENTRIES

Entries are open until **5rd August, 17:00** (entry fee applies according to the table.);

Late entries open until **6th August, 17:00** (10 Eur per seat).

After the application period, crew changes or cancellations shall be made by submitting a completed "Crew Change" form to entry@lif.lt until **7th August, 13:00**.

Entry fee shall not be refunded upon crew withdrawal except cases when doctor's certificate stating that the athlete has fallen ill after the entry was submitted. The entry fee already paid will not be credited towards the payment of new crews after the entry deadline.

Late entry fee of **10 EUR** (per crew) will be applied (**from August 5th 17:00**), according to the table. If the team manager does not withdraw the crew by **13:00 on 7th of August**, the team will be fined **20 EUR** (per crew). If the team manager does not withdraw the crew on time, and the crew does not arrive at the start, the team shall be fined **50 euros** (per crew).

The entry fee must be paid to the Lithuanian Rowing Federation via the electronic entry system.

RACE SCHEDULE

After the entry deadline, the latest version of the provisional race schedule will be sent to all participants by email and published on www.lif.lt

BOATS & EQUIPMENT

Boats and equipment will be provided by provided by the Lithuanian Rowing Federation.

ACCOMMODATION

Priority accommodation is available for up to two athletes and one coach per country and will be covered by Lithuanian Rowing Federation.

RESPONSIBILITY OF TEAM MANAGERS

Teams are reminded that coastal rowing is an assumed risk sport and the Team manager shall be responsible to assess the risks and the ability of the crew to cope with the prevailing and forecast conditions (see World Rowing Rules of Racing Appendix R18 19.c.ii) Crews that feel that they are not competent or confident to train or race in the conditions are expected to not go on the water and to inform the organising committee at the earliest opportunity of their decision.

OFFICIAL TRAINING SESSIONS

Official training sessions at the competition venue will be organized on 6–7 August 2026.

Training sessions will be conducted in 25-minute time slots.
The fee for one seat in a boat is EUR 15 per session.

To ensure equal opportunities for all participants, registration for training sessions will open on 20 July 2026.
